## Louisiana Medicaid Managed Care Plan Progesterone Billing and Ordering Guide

## Ordering Options, Coding, Billing: ICD-10 Diagnosis Codes: 009.212, 009.213, 009.219

- 1. Home Administration of Injectable Progesterone (Makena and Compounded 17P) is available for all Health Plans in all parishes from Optum OB Homecare (formerly Alere Health). Call 800-999-2106. Explain to the patient that Optum will contact her directly. AmerihealthCaritas patients' Makena home administration: Contact Perform Specialty Pharmacy (see AmerihealthCaritas below for contact information).
- 2. Physician/Provider orders Progesterone from Specialty Pharmacy (see each Health Plan below) for a specific patient. Specialty Pharmacy bills patient's insurer.
- 3. "Buy & Bill" (non-patient-specific): Physician/Provider buys a quantity of Progesterone from manufacturer, pharmacy, or distributor. Physician/ Provider bills patient's insurer after administration. Compounded 17P Code: J3490-TH (\$69 per dose) or Makena Code: J1725 (\$2.76 per mg).
